flourished – what remains when prosperity has ceased. It is a picture of finality: lifeless, left over, and seemingly without a future. A stump marks the end of what was, destined to rot and eventually disappear.

This verse refers to the royal line of David, reduced to a remnant – a stump. Remnants are the survivors, those who have endured trials, faced adversity, and remained steadfast. Isaiah 11:1 is a promise of what God intends to do for His faithful remnant: those who have clung to Him through every storm, standing firm on the foundation of Jesus Christ.

God's original plan was for David and his descendants to rule on the throne forever. Yet, history tells a different story. In 2 Kings 24 and 25, we learn that Zedekiah, the last king of Judah (whose name means "Gift of God"), was captured by Nebuchadnezzar, bringing the royal authority of David's line to an apparent end. For nearly 600 years, there was no king in Israel.

During this silence, it seemed as though God had forgotten His promise. But God was not unfaithful; He was waiting for His appointed time. The people of Israel waited with great anticipation for the coming of the King of the Jews. And then, in the fullness of time, God declared that a shoot would emerge from the stump of Jesse.

### The Shoot!

How could life spring from a dead stump? It seemed impossible. But with God, even the most hopeless situations can be revived. What appeared to be the end of Israel – its mighty kingdom reduced to a lifeless remnant – became the stage for the fulfillment of God's promise through the birth of Jesus Christ.

Contrary to the expectations of the Israelites, who imagined the Messiah as a mighty and powerful king ready to overthrow their oppressors, Jesus came humbly, born in a manger. Sometimes, God's promises unfold in ways that defy human expectations. Yet, His plans are always perfect.

From the stump of Jesse, a shoot emerges – a symbol of new life, hope, and restoration.

### Reflection on the Shoot!

We can use the acrostic "SHOOT" to meditate on the imagery of the shoot from the stump.

### S → 1. SOURCE OF PROMISES!

Our God is a God of promises. He makes covenants and never goes back on His Word. When our foundation is built on His promises, we are more than conquerors because His promises are "Yes" and "Amen" in Jesus Christ. God never forgets His Word. He fulfills His promises, even in unexpected seasons, for He is a faithful promise-keeper.

He kept His promise to David: **Your house and Your kingdom will endure forever before me; Your throne will be established forever.** 2 Samuel 7:16 (AMP).

**... I will not leave you until I have done what I have promised you.** Genesis 28:15 (AMP).



### God promised - Abraham descendants would be as numerous as the stars

In Genesis 22, God promised Abraham that his descendants would be as numerous as the stars. However, Abraham's faith was tested when God asked him to sacrifice his son Isaac, the child of promise. Just as Abraham raised the knife, God provided a ram as a substitute sacrifice. This story demonstrates that God is faithful to sustain His promises, even when circumstances make them seem impossible.

Claim His promises today!



The message of Jesus Christ is one of hope – hope for everyone, even in hopeless situations. Around the world, many people are struggling because they have lost hope in their relationships, finances, future, jobs and most importantly, in themselves. The

good news is that Jesus Christ restores hope to lifeless situations.

Just as a shoot can emerge from a dead stump, Jesus Christ transforms lifeless circumstances into sources of new life. One of the central messages of Jesus' birth is this: hope. The stump, once lifeless and beyond hope, will bring forth a shoot – a new life!

This stump, once a flourishing green tree with flowers, leaves, birds nesting in its branches, and offering shade and protection, now stands broken, empty, and lifeless. It seems useless, without purpose, and left to decay. Yet, out of this desolation, a shoot emerges – a new branch full of life.



### Zarephath was gathering sticks!

During a severe famine, the widow of Zarephath was gathering sticks to prepare a final meal for herself and her son before they perished. At Elijah's request, she used her last bit of flour and oil to make him bread. Miraculously, God provided for her household, ensuring the jar of flour and the jug of oil never ran dry.

This story (1 Kings 17:7-16) illustrates how God restores hope and sustenance in the most desperate situations, much like the shoot from a lifeless stump.

No matter how hopeless your situation seems, trust in Jesus. He is the source of promises and the restorer of hope.

### God's Restoration and New Beginnings!

#### God Restores Hope:

God can do the same in our lives as He did for others – transform hopeless situations into sources of joy and restoration. Like the widow who brought her troubles to the feet of God, we too must surrender our burdens to Jesus Christ. When we give Him everything, He turns our sorrow into joy and restores our hope. Even the hope we thought was lost can be renewed in the name of Jesus Christ.



God calls us not to remain victims of our circumstances but to rise as overcomers. Regardless of how this year has been for you or the baggage you may still carry from the past, remember this: Jesus Christ restores what is broken or lost. He reconciles us to the Father because He is a God of restoration and reconciliation.

No matter what you have lost – whether through disobedience, sin or distance from God – He can restore it. If He restored our relationship with the Father through His sacrifice, how much more will He restore other aspects of our lives? Jesus Christ came to die so that we could be reconciled to God. Whatever you have lost, claim His promise and trust Him to restore it.

If God can bring life to a dead, lifeless stump, how much more can He do for you and me?

Consider Job's story in Job 42: he lost everything – his children, wealth, and health. Yet, despite his intense suffering, Job remained faithful. In the end, God restored everything to him, giving him twice as much as he had before. This demonstrates that God is a restorer who abundantly blesses even after unimaginable loss.



### David recovered everything

Similarly, David lost everything to the Amalekites in 1 Samuel 30. Instead of despairing, he sought

strength in the Lord and recovered everything. May the Lord restore all that you have lost—everything.

### 4. OPENER OF NEW BEGINNINGS!




The Bible assures us that God has a plan for each of us – a plan to give us hope and a future. We are engraved on the palms of His hands. However, life can sometimes take unexpected turns, and we may feel lost along the way.

The beauty of Jesus Christ is that He is the God of second chances. Even when we make mistakes, He can create something beautiful from our mess. As Romans 8:28 (NKJV) says, ... All things work together for good to those who love God...

He is the opener of new doors and new beginnings. I pray that as you read this, new opportunities will arise, and fresh starts will come into your life. Jesus Christ came to give us purpose and life in abundance. Surrender your life to Him in prayer, and He will make all things new.

God creates life where there was none, transforming hopelessness into a fresh start. A shoot – a symbol of new life – will emerge from the stump of what once seemed dead. God has the power to bring life to the very places of lifelessness. Ezekiel 37 reminds us to speak to the dry bones; they will come back to life. Speak life into every dead situation, for that is the promise of Jesus Christ's birth.

Ezekiel saw a vision of a valley filled with dry bones. When God commanded him to prophesy, the bones came together, were covered with flesh, and received breath, becoming a vast army. This powerful image of resurrection and renewal assures us that God can create new beginnings even in the most barren and lifeless circumstances.

# PIT TO PALACE

(Life experiences of Pastor S. Sam Selva Raj)

**“Whoever reads, let him understand” (Matthew 24:15)**

← **... Whoever trusts in the Lord, happy is he. Proverbs 16:20.** →

After the initial years of my ministry, I began to develop a deep curiosity about how Christian ministers in foreign countries lived, how they nurtured their spiritual lives, and how ministries were conducted in those nations. At that time, however, I lacked financial resources, public support and even sufficient spiritual gifts.

To my own surprise, I found the courage to write in my diary in 1989 that I would visit Malaysia in August of that year. I soon forgot about it and didn't revisit the idea for nearly three months. One day, I stumbled upon my diary and was reminded of my plan. Realizing that the proposed date of my visit was fast approaching, I brought the matter before the Lord in prayer, trusting in His word: **Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God.** Philippians 4:6.

Days turned into weeks, yet nothing seemed to happen. I knew in my heart that I had no means to travel abroad, but my faith in God remained unwavering. During this time, I met a brother who frequently traveled to Malaysia for ministry. I shared my desire with him, and he encouraged me to visit his home in Chennai for further guidance.

The following morning, I went to his house. Unfortunately, he was preoccupied and asked me to return the next day. This pattern continued for over a month. Each visit cost me both time and money, only for me to realize that he was unwilling to help. Finally, he told me bluntly, “You cannot go to Malaysia. Only gifted and capable people like me can minister there. No one in Malaysia will accept you. Don't come to me anymore.”

Despite his discouragement, I didn't lose hope. I continued to pray, waiting patiently for God's will to be revealed.

Two weeks later, as I was sorting through letters in my office, I found a letter from Malaysia. It was from Pastor Devarajulu, who was ministering there. His words were as follows:

*My dear brother in Christ, Bro. Sam Selva Raj,*

*I am a lover of books. Today, I visited a shop that sells old books, and there, I came across an old, torn copy of your Echo of His Call magazine. As I read it, the Lord spoke to me. Kindly send me your earlier issues as well; I will bear the postal expenses. I would also like to meet you in person. I am willing to cover your travel, food, and accommodation costs. Please come to Malaysia. Furthermore, I will arrange for you to minister in Singapore and Indonesia. We need ministers of God like you. Kindly reply immediately.*

I was overwhelmed by God's faithfulness. As I had written in my diary, I was able to visit Malaysia in August 1989, through Pastor Devarajulu's invitation. I also traveled to Singapore and Indonesia, where I preached to hundreds of people, sharing the message of deliverance from sin, curses, and poverty through the Lord Jesus Christ. God not only blessed me with the opportunity to minister but also allowed me to form lasting friendships with several ministers of God in those countries—friendships that continue to this day.

Since then, the Lord has expanded my ministry, enabling me to preach His word in nations like South Africa, America, England, Scotland, France, Germany, Switzerland, Canada, Australia, and Sri Lanka. Thousands have heard the message of salvation through Jesus Christ. Today, I receive countless invitations to minister in various countries, but I lack the time to accept them all. Such is the extent of God's blessing in my life.

Dear reader, the Lord Jesus Christ whom I serve is the one true God. He is the way, the truth and the life. Trust Him. Surrender your life to Him. If you feel called to serve Him, step forward in faith. He will guide you in extraordinary ways and bless you abundantly.

A shoot from a stump! He calls into existence things that do not yet exist. As Romans 4:17 (NKJV) declares: ... **He (who) gives life to the dead and calls those things which do not exist as though they did.**

Do not lose hope! A new beginning is awaiting you. If you believe, you will see the glory of God. Trust in Him, for God is not limited. Even when we face challenges that seem insurmountable, He is able to do the impossible.

## 5. THE TRUE VINE!

Jesus Christ, the True Vine, enables us to live abundantly and bear fruit for God's glory. We must rely on Him for fruitfulness. Jesus Christ came into the world so we could become children of God and

bear fruit for His kingdom. **Without Him, we can do nothing** (John 15:5).

The branch symbolizes fruitfulness, growth and abundance. As followers of Jesus Christ, we are called to bear fruit so that the Father in heaven may be glorified. Jesus Christ taught His disciples that He is the True Vine, and they are the branches. He encouraged them to remain in Him, for apart from Him, they could do nothing. Those who abide in Him bear much fruit, glorifying the Father (John 15).

This truth directly reflects the idea of growth and fruitfulness through reliance on Jesus Christ, the True Vine.

It is my prayer that as you meditate on Isaiah 11:1, God will bring a new shoot into your life, your family, your ministry and your workplace. This small but significant shoot will bring transformation and renewal.

I pray for this new beginning to take root in your life this year. May you trust in the Source of all hope, who restores every loss and brings beauty from ashes. He is the God of restoration, the One who opens doors to new beginnings!

I pray that this year will be a year of renewal and fruitfulness in every area of your life. As you abide in Him, may you experience multiplication, growth, and abundance. Trust in Him, and you will bear much fruit, bringing glory to the Father.
