Was He not concerned about the ninety-nine? I understand that the one lost sheep must have been precious - but still, why would He leave the ninety-nine behind? Have you ever wondered about them? **The ninety-nine, the nine coins, and the older brother** - 99:9:1.

If you were in a similar situation, would you leave the ninety-nine to search for the one? Not only did He leave them, but He left them in the wilderness. That made me think even harder. It wasn't a safe place - He didn't leave them in a pen or a secure enclosure. They were out in the open, surrounded by wild animals and other dangers. He could have lost the ninety-nine while searching for the one.

I don't know if anyone else has thought about this the way I do. Maybe the lost sheep was young and curious, eager to explore, and simply got lost in the process. Or perhaps it was rebellious and disobedient, always wandering away, ignoring the Shepherd's guidance.

Regardless of the reason, the Shepherd was willing to leave the ninety-nine in the wilderness - exposed and vulnerable - to go after the one. This thought has been on my mind for quite some time. There must be a reason why He made that choice.

THE SHEPHERD'S CONFIDENCE IN THE 99:



1. THE POWER OF UNITY!

The shepherd must have had immense confidence in the 99

to leave them behind in the open wilderness. It was likely He knew they had each other's backs - standing together in unity, committed to supporting and sustaining one another at all times. Even in the face of danger, they could unite as a formidable force.

I am certain the shepherd had trained them well in the power of togetherness. If one sheep were attacked, the other 98 would instinctively rush to its aid - fiercely protective, unwavering in their defense. There is great strength in unity.

The shepherd also understood that the one who was lost was vulnerable - completely alone, with no one to defend or support. The chances of survival are slim, not only due to external threats but also because of the weight of isolation. Being alone is a dangerous place to be. That is why the Bible encourages us to remain together:

Again, truly I tell you that if two of you on earth agree about anything they ask for, it will be done for them by My Father in heaven

(Matthew 18:19).

For where two or three gather in My name, there am I with them (Matthew 18:20).

How good and pleasant it is when God's people live together in unity! (Psalm 133:1).

At times, we may feel it is better to be alone than to be around people who do not share our values, appreciate us, or genuinely love us. It is especially painful when those closest to us betray or hurt us, making it difficult to trust anyone again.

Dear brothers and sisters, if you have experienced this or are going through it now, I pray that the Lord heals your wounds. Jesus Christ Himself endured betrayal on His way to the cross, so He understands your pain, hesitation, and doubts.

Yes, trusting people in this world can be difficult. Sadly, this is one reason many hesitate to attend Church. If you are avoiding Church because of the people there, I want to encourage you - please go! It is not just a suggestion but a command from God:

And let us not neglect our meeting together, as some people do, but encourage one another, especially now that the day of His return is drawing near.

(Hebrews 10:25).

Do not distance yourself from the Church. Remember, we live in an imperfect world among imperfect people, but the God of perfection will give us the grace to love and the wisdom to discern. In Acts 12, when the Church prayed together, God miraculously opened the prison doors for Peter. There is great power when believers unite in prayer and fellowship.

God miraculously opened the prison doors for Peter.

Love covers all things, and we need one another. There is a beautiful saying in English: "If you want to walk fast, walk alone. But if you want to walk far, walk with someone." However, be mindful of whom you choose to walk with and have fellowship with, for they will influence you. This is why Psalm 1 teaches us to avoid certain associations in order to prosper. Unity is essential, but the wrong company can lead to disaster.

Jesus Christ offered a profound prayer: "...that they may be one as we are one - I in them and You in Me - so that they may be brought to complete unity." (John 17:22-23).

While the shepherd's pursuit of the one lost sheep is a powerful illustration of God's radical mercy, the ninety-nine represents a larger community meant to rejoice in restoration. When one member returns, the joy

is not just for the rescued but for the entire flock. This teaches us that God values each individual and that restoration is a communal event - an invitation for everyone to celebrate and take part in bringing others back into the fold.

secure in their faith, but even among the ninety-nine, some may be wandering. Be watchful!

When the watchman sees the enemy approaching, he sounds the alarm to warn the people (Ezekiel 33:3-9).

In the same way, the commitment of the ninety-nine helps prevent spiritual complacency and strengthens the overall health of the community. God has positioned us as watchmen in the places He has placed us - let us be vigilant!

2. A CALL TO VIGILANCE AND ACTIVE RESTORATION!

The shepherd expects the ninety-nine to be vigilant and watchful. They are called to be the first to notice when someone begins to drift away and to gently guide that person back. The ninety-nine bear a greater responsibility - how else would the shepherd know that one is missing? Surely, at least one among them would have raised the alarm. Perhaps it was the lost one's mother, brother, sister, friend, grandparent, or spouse. If it were an older sheep, perhaps the younger ones would have noticed and informed the shepherd.

Jesus Christ expects the remaining ninety-nine to stay alert. If you consider yourself as one among the ninety-nine, then you have a duty toward the lost. We must be attentive to our family members, friends, and, above all, our Church community. Too often, we assume that those around us are

3. A WARNING AGAINST COMPLACENCY AND SELF-RIGHTEOUSNESS!

Sometimes, being part of the ninety-nine - feeling safe and protected - can lead to complacency and an attitude of self-righteousness. We may think, "Oh, I am in the fold. I am doing what is expected of me. I follow and obey the Shepherd. I am not like the one who wanders." However, the safety of the ninety-nine can create a false sense of security. Being part of the flock does not make one spiritually immune or self-sufficient.

The parable challenges the **righteous** who might believe, "I don't need repentance," by

PIT TO PALACE

(Life experiences of Pastor S. Sam Selva Raj)

“Whoever reads, let him understand” (Matthew 24:15)

DO NOT GIVE UP! DO NOT WITHDRAW!

Now the just shall live by faith; but if anyone draws back, My soul has no pleasure in him. But we are not of those who draw back to perdition, but of those who believe to the saving of the soul. - Hebrews 10:38–39

From the early days of my ministry, without any human support to rely on, I faced great tribulations and endured unspeakable hardships from the very people I lived among. Sleepless nights and fearful days made me question whether God had truly called me or if I had entered the ministry by my own will.

There were times when I suffered starvation and physical attacks, yet God remained silent. He did not answer my prayers. On several occasions, I felt abandoned. But as time passed, I came to understand that even His silence was an answer - a lesson teaching me about the world and its people.

In 1979, I encountered severe opposition while preaching the gospel of Jesus Christ. I had been conducting prayer meetings in a rented building when some individuals approached the owner with false accusations against me. They convinced her to forbid me from holding gatherings there any longer.

Heartbroken, I returned home, locked the doors, and opened all the water taps in my kitchen and bathroom. I wept bitterly, crying out to the Lord. The sound of rushing water masked my sobs from the outside world. Yet, even then, God remained silent.

Looking at my life, I saw challenges and difficulties on one side, and on the other, the very Master who had called me into ministry standing still, seemingly doing nothing to help me. Meanwhile, my opposers grew stronger, mocking me openly. They even entered the government office where I worked, spreading false rumors and slandering me in front of my colleagues.

I was deeply troubled - irritated, afraid, and overwhelmed by the harm they inflicted upon me. That day, I cried out in desperation:

“O Lord of Israel, O God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob! I can no longer endure Your silence! If You will not act on my behalf, whom will You help? If You refuse to protect me, where else can I turn?”

Yet, there was no reply, no guidance, no inspiration - only silence. My spirit was utterly disturbed. That night, in my despair, I packed all my household belongings and ministry materials, preparing to leave it all behind and return to my native place.

... For fear of the oppressing sword, everyone shall turn to his own people, and everyone shall flee to his own land - Jeremiah 50:16

At exactly 2:00 A.M., I heard someone knocking at my door. My hands were trembling, and I felt both helpless and nervous. Eventually, I opened the door to find an elderly man with a white beard, carrying a bag over his shoulder and a parcel of food.

I asked, “Who are you? What brings you here at this hour?” I also mentioned that I was preparing to return to my native place because God had not answered my prayers. However, he pleaded with me to let him in, explaining that the neighbors might misinterpret the situation given the late hour. I reluctantly invited him inside.

He began, “My son Sam, I am your friend, Pastor J.S. Daniel. It has been a long time since we last met, and perhaps you have forgotten me. I was returning to my village after completing my ministry in the city, but I missed my last bus. I have no money to hire a taxi, nor do I have a place to sleep in this city. While walking along Mount Road in Chennai, God spoke to me, directing me clearly to find you tonight. You must not leave this place. Do not assume that your God, who has called you, is silent; He is actively

preparing you for a better tomorrow. He is sharpening you to achieve something great in your life. He is not silent as you believe. Remember, **the gospel is to be sent forth from Jerusalem** (Isaiah 2:3, Micah 4:2). This city is your Jerusalem. So, do not leave this city”

I had no other option but to obey Him, and I felt the Lord's love and witnessed the miraculous ways He works in the life of a humble servant like me. I sought pardon from both Pastor Daniel and our Lord Jesus Christ, and then continued my ministry. God blessed me. reminding them that God's grace is available to all - even those who appear secure. As Scripture says, **For all have sinned and come short of the glory of God** (Romans 3:23). In this way, the ninety-nine prompt us to examine our own hearts for signs of complacency or pride.
