### A KING WHO BEGAN WELL BUT DID NOT FINISH WELL!

This truth reminds me of king Amaziah who started his journey strongly, yet his ending was tragic. Scripture reveals the reason clearly:

**... He did what was right in the sight of the LORD, but not with a loyal heart.**

- 2 Chronicles 25:2

### Who was Amaziah?

- ◆ Amaziah was the son of King Joash, who became king at the age of seven
- ◆ He was the ninth king of Judah



9th King of Judah

- ◆ His story is recorded in 2 Kings 14 and 2 Chronicles 25.

The Bible tells us something remarkable - and yet deeply concerning:

**He did what was right in the sight of the Lord... but not with a loyal heart.**

- ◆ What does it mean to serve God without a loyal heart?
- ◆ Is it possible to do what is right before God and still not be fully surrendered?
- ◆ Can we serve God outwardly while our hearts remain divided?

Amaziah is one of the most tragic kings in Scripture - not because he was evil, but because he was almost good, partially obedient, and half-hearted.

- He obeyed
- He did good
- He followed God's commands

Yet his heart was not fully surrendered.

This is not just Amaziah's story - it is the story of many believers today. We love God. We follow Him. Yet there may be areas of our lives we have kept off-limits to Him.

We may:

- Attend Church
- Serve faithfully
- Give to charity
- Help the needy
- Obey in many areas

But the crucial question remains:

Where is our heart before God?

My father often said, "Partial obedience is complete disobedience."

At the beginning of this year, one question we must ask if we want to finish 2026 well is:

### Lessons from the Life of Amaziah!

I love meditating on the  
lives of the kings of Judah and  
Israel. Their stories offer powerful



*Amaziah began well but,  
he did not finish well*

lessons and mirrors for our own  
lives. Amaziah began well, but  
something went wrong down the  
line - and it led to serious  
consequences.

## I. COMMITMENT!

### Amaziah Began Well!

*(2 Chronicles 25:1-10)*

He did what was right in  
the eyes of the LORD, but not as  
his father David had done. In  
everything he followed the  
example of his father Joash.

- 2 Kings 14:3



*Amaziah followed  
the example of his father Joash,  
but not as King David*

Amaziah had a strong  
beginning and demonstrated  
obedience in several areas.

### (A) Obedience to God's Word and Justice!

When Amaziah came to the  
throne, he executed justice on those  
who murdered his father. However,  
he did not kill their children,  
obeying God's law:

Children shall not be put  
to death for the sins of their  
fathers. (Deuteronomy 24:16)

This required courage. He  
could have feared revenge, but he  
chose obedience. (2 Kings 14:6)  
Unlike Queen Athaliah (2 Kings  
11:1), who killed all potential heirs,  
Amaziah honored God's law.

He began well.

### (B) Obedience Despite Personal Loss!

Amaziah hired 100,000  
soldiers from Israel, a costly  
investment. When the prophet  
instructed him not to use them,  
Amaziah asked a sincere question:



*But what about the  
hundred talents I paid?*

... But what about the  
hundred talents I paid? ...  
2 Chronicles 25:9.

The prophet replied:

The LORD is able to give  
you much more than this.

(2 Chronicles 25:9)

Though obedience cost him  
greatly, Amaziah listened. He sent  
the soldiers home and trusted God.

Obedience always costs -  
but disobedience costs far more.

At this point, Amaziah  
appeared to be a godly king, and  
God honored him.

Yet Scripture warns us:

He did right... but not with a loyal heart.

**(C) Commitment Without Full Surrender!**

Amaziah was not wicked or rebellious. He followed his godly



'Shalem' means fully surrendered

father Joash - unlike David, who served God wholeheartedly.

He started well, but God is not looking for good starters but for good finishers. Amaziah did right but not with a loyal heart.

The Hebrew word "shalem" means whole, complete, undivided, fully surrendered.

Amaziah's problem was partial obedience. He followed God outwardly but kept areas of his heart untouched.

Dear brothers and sisters, it is possible to:

- Give tithes
- Serve faithfully
- Live morally

Yet still cling to pride, unforgiveness, lust, gossip, hidden sins, or self-rule.

Outward obedience without inward surrender leads to spiritual emptiness. One should be deeply rooted and bear fruit upwards.

## 2. COMPROMISE!

**What He Allowed Eventually Destroyed Him!**

(2 Chronicles 25:11-16)

The high places, however, were not removed; ...

- 2 Kings 14:4

Amaziah tolerated what he should have destroyed.

Compromise always begins small - but what we tolerate today will dominate us tomorrow.

# PIT TO PALACE

(Life experiences of Pastor S. Sam Selva Raj)

*"Whoever reads, let him understand" (Matthew 24:15)*



## THE LORD WHO CONSIDERED MY LOWLY STATE!

During the early days of my ministry, I had stayed with one of my friend's family in a foreign country for few days. They provided all my basic needs and made my stay comfortable there.

One evening, my friend who was hosting me came into my room and said, "I feel that you have been praying to God for some particular need. Can I know about it?"

Will you explain to me about that? I replied, "We have been printing our magazine, *Echo of His Call*, in other presses.

Since we find it very difficult to publish it in on time, I am praying with a great burden for an offset printing machine". He said that he would also pray for that need.

Next day, while I was about to leave the house for ministry, my friend and his wife approached me. They showed me the documents that included their application and the declaration to a bank, in which they had decided to mortgage their house to receive a huge amount, from which they wanted to buy the machine needed for the *Echo of His Call* ministry.



I was shocked and disturbed in my spirit and said to them firmly, "I will not accept the money you are going to take as a loan from the bank".

That family was surprised at my attitude. They labeled me as one, "who doesn't know to survive in the world". They continued to convince me to accept the offer. But I was firm on my decision and continued to pray.

After some days, I returned to India. The Lord inspired the hearts of my poor Indian friends and with the offerings they gave me now and then I was able to buy a good offset machine.

I could experience and taste, that the Lord is good (Psalm 34:8). The Lord's grace upholds me according to Proverbs 28:20. **"A faithful man will abound with blessings"**.

Though *Echo of His Call* ministry doesn't have a regular, definite income, the Lord meets all the needs through our faith in Him. All glory and praise be to God, Amen.

**After defeating the Edomites, Amaziah brought back their idols and worshipped them** (2 Chronicles 25:14).

Think about this:

God gave him victory

- Pride entered
- Discernment left
- Compromise followed

He bowed to the gods of a defeated people. This is how deceptive sin can be.

### (B) Rejection of Correction!

Earlier, Amaziah accepted correction. Now, filled with pride, he rejected it.

**... Why do you consult this people's gods, which could not save their own people from your hand? 2 Chronicles 25:15**

Amaziah responded arrogantly:

**Who appointed you my counselor?** (2 Chronicles 25:16).

What a difference in his attitude! The moment we stop listening to God's correction, we begin our descent toward destruction.

He obeyed when it was convenient; but when obedience became uncomfortable, he rejected it. It is not sin that destroys us first - it is the refusal to accept God's correction. My prayer for this year is that God will help us hear His



voice at every step and walk faithfully in His ways.

**Whether you turn to the right or to the left, your ears will hear a voice behind you, saying, "This is the way; walk in it."** Isaiah 30:21.

Above all, we must learn to surrender fully and obey that guiding voice.

### (C) Compromise led to pride, rebellion and blindness!

Compromise produces a dangerous chain reaction:

- Pride
- Idolatry
- Rejection of counsel
- Self-reliance
- Ignoring warnings
- Foolish decisions

Commitment without surrender always leads to compromise.

### 3. CONSEQUENCE!

#### What You Don't Surrender Will Destroy You!

(2 Chronicles 25:17-28)

#### (A) A Battle that God Did Not Authorize!

Proud of his success, Amaziah challenged the king of Israel to war. God was not with him.

Confidence without God is dangerous. He assumed that success was proof of God's approval. The king of Israel warned him with a parable but Amaziah ignored it. When a

person's heart is not surrendered to God, he stops listening to everyone, even the one whom God sends.

#### (B) Ignoring Wise Warnings!

Even the enemy recognized Amaziah's pride:

**Your heart is lifted up to boast. Stay at home** (2 Chronicles 25:19)

When 'Pride' blinds us to truth we stop listening even to common sense. May the Lord prevent us from this foolishness.

#### (C) Total Collapse for Amaziah!

Because of compromise:

His army was defeated



*Jerusalem's wall was broken*

- Jerusalem's wall was broken
- The temple was plundered
- He was captured
- His life ended in shame and conspiracy

The man who began committed, ended completely broken.

Why?

Because he did right - but not with a loyal heart.

They fall gradually - through small compromises.

Commitment -----  
Compromise ----- Consequence

### A Final Call: Choose Complete Surrender!

Dear friends, God is not demanding perfection - but He is calling for wholehearted devotion.

- Commitment is good
- Partial surrender is dangerous
- Compromise will grow
- Consequences will follow

Out of love and mercy, God calls us:

"Why turn to what cannot save you? Come back. Surrender fully."

Jesus gave His life on the cross so that you and I may live fully surrendered lives.

"Come back. Surrender fully."

Return to God - He is waiting with open arms. Let us not walk the slippery path that led Amaziah astray. This is the very reason Christ came into the world and laid down His life on the cross of Calvary, to redeem you and me.

#### Let Us Reflect!

- Are we committed in some areas but compromised in others?
- What "high places" have we not torn down - bitterness, secret habits, addictions?
- What part of our heart is not fully loyal to God?

Let us pray and strive to finish 2026 doing what is right in the sight of the Lord - with a loyal heart.
