perseverance, and unwavering dedication became the foundation upon which our liberty was built. The sacrifice of those who lived nearly eight decades ago became the price paid for the freedom we enjoy today. Their blood became the seed from which our nation's independence blossomed.

This reminds me of an even greater sacrifice - the sacrifice of our Lord Jesus Christ on the cross of Calvary more than 2,000 years ago. His precious blood purchased for us a far greater and eternal freedom: freedom from sin, sickness, addictions, spiritual bondage, and generational curses.

The Word of God declares:

He became the curse for us (Galatians 3:13).

Through His sacrifice, we have been delivered from darkness and brought into His marvelous light. Jesus Christ Himself declared:

... You shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free. John 8:32.

Praise God - we are truly free in Jesus Christ!

Jesus Christ and the Storm:

In Mark Chapter 4, we read the powerful account of Jesus Christ sleeping in the boat while His disciples faced a violent storm. Overcome by fear, they awakened Him and cried out:

... Teacher, do You not care that we are perishing?

Jesus Christ arose, rebuked the wind and the sea, and then challenged His disciples regarding their faith. They were filled with awe as they witnessed His absolute authority over creation itself.

Mark 4:36 says:

... They took Him along in the boat as He was. ...

Jesus Christ had been ministering continually. He was physically weary, emotionally exhausted, and needed a moment of rest away from the crowds - a quiet time with His disciples.

They took Him "just as He was" - tired, worn, and in need of sleep. As soon as the boat began its journey, Jesus Christ fell asleep.

Many of us can relate to this. After a long day of labour,



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ministry, responsibilities, or service, the moment we find a quiet place, exhaustion overtakes us.

Yet within this same verse, there is a small but significant detail that is often overlooked - a detail carrying a deep spiritual revelation:

"And there were also other little boats with Him."

Mark alone records this detail. The Gospel of Mark contains many vivid eyewitness descriptions, believed to have been influenced by Peter, a fisherman and one of Jesus' closest disciples.

Mark uniquely records several details, including:

* **Jesus Christ sleeping on a pillow** (Mark 4:38)

* **The green grass at the feeding of the five thousand** (Mark 6:39)

* **The groups of hundreds and fifties** (Mark 6:40)

* **The two-stage healing of the blind man** (Mark 8:22-25)

Therefore, when Mark writes, ... **Other little boats were with Him,** it is not an unnecessary detail. It reveals a powerful spiritual truth:

Your life is being watched. Your storms are being observed. Your testimony of deliverance can become someone else's doorway to freedom. I thank God for the little boats that followed Jesus Christ in the middle of the storm.

WHAT DO THE LITTLE BOATS REMIND US?

1. Remember: You Are Surrounded by Little Boats That Are Watching You.

God has called us to proclaim His praises:

But you are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, His own special people, that you may proclaim the praises of Him who called you

out of darkness into His marvelous light; 1 Peter 2:9.

We have received freedom in Christ not merely for ourselves, but so that His light may shine through our lives and lead others to Him.

Whether we realise it or not, people are watching us - our faith, our attitude, our words, our actions, our responses under pressure, and the way we conduct ourselves in the storms of life.

Jesus Christ said:

Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven. Matthew 5:16.

Even in the middle of storms, may our lives reveal the goodness of God and cause others to glorify our Father in heaven.

I do not know why those little boats followed Jesus' boat. Perhaps:

- * Some followed out of curiosity
- * Some followed because they were amazed by His works
- * Some followed to observe and criticize
- * Some followed because they were hungry for the Word
- * Some were simply nearby, like fishermen and traveler

Whatever their reason, they were witnesses to how the disciples responded when the storm arrived.

Who are these little boats around us?

- * Our children
- * Our spouse
- * Our family members
- * Our colleagues
- * Our neighbours
- * Our Church family
- * Our community

You are not sailing through life alone. There are little boats sailing alongside you, observing your journey.

2. Remember: You Carry Jesus Christ - They Don't:

The greatest difference between the disciples' boat and the little boats was not the storm - it was the presence of Jesus Christ.

The little boats were on the same waters and faced the same storm, but Jesus Christ was not in their boat.

However, we carry Jesus Christ wherever we go. We are the temple of the Holy Spirit. The presence of Jesus Christ is with us.

Yet many around us are still living without Him - trapped in fear, confusion, hopelessness, spiritual bondage, and the chains of sin. They are watching how those who carry Jesus Christ respond, speak, and live.

Jesus Christ declared:

The Spirit of the Lord is upon Me, because He has anointed Me to preach the gospel to the poor. He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives and recovery of sight to the blind, to set at liberty those who are oppressed. Luke 4:18.

Remember this: you are an ambassador of freedom.

God has set you free so that you can become a channel of His freedom to the little boats around you.

Never forget who is in your boat - and who is not.

Your life is a message that people are already reading.

What message are you preaching?

3. Remember: The Storm Touches Every Boat

The storm did not strike only the boat carrying Jesus Christ; it affected every boat on the water.

Both believers and unbelievers face storms. Having

Jesus Christ in our boat does not mean we will never encounter storms - but it means we have a Saviour who is greater than every storm.

Our storms may come through:

- * Emotional battles
- * Financial pressures
- * Family struggles
- * Health challenges
- * Spiritual attacks

The enemy uses storms to make us focus only on our own pain and forget the little boats around us. He desires to overwhelm us with

- * Anxiety and emotional burdens
- * Family responsibilities
- * Financial difficulties
- * Physical weakness
- * Spiritual weariness

When we become completely consumed by our own struggles, we fail to notice those who need our prayers, encouragement, compassion, and testimony.

But God calls us to rise above the storm.

Isaiah 40:31 declares:

But those who wait on the LORD shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings like eagles, they shall run and not be weary, they shall walk and not faint.

You may feel as though you are walking through a lonely valley, carrying burdens too heavy to bear, wishing for an escape from the

storm. Yet the God who called you remains faithful.

The storm you are facing today may become the testimony that brings hope and freedom to countless little boats watching your journey.

The very battle you are experiencing now, God can transform into a blessing for others - even those you may never know.

Be courageous.

Show the little boats what it means to have Jesus Christ in your boat.

4. Your Response in the Storm Influences the Little Boats

When the disciples panicked and cried:

"Teacher, do You not care that we are perishing?" The little boats around them must have been filled with fear.

If the boat carrying Jesus Christ was trembling, what hope did the others have?

Your response in a crisis often speaks louder than your words in times of comfort.

Do you respond like those who have no hope? Or do you reveal the One who is with you in the storm?

The three Hebrew young men declared:

"Our God whom we serve is able to deliver us... But even if He does not..." (Daniel 3:17-18)

What a powerful expression of faith:

"Even if He does not."

Do we have that kind of faith that does not depend only on circumstances - a faith that strengthens every little boat watching from afar??

Paul declared:

... I know whom I have believed. ... 2 Timothy 1:12.

Your faith during the storm can become someone else's strength.

5. Remember: The Little Boats Lean On Your Deliverance

When Jesus Christ calmed the storm, every little boat around Him experienced the impact of His power. The miracle was not only for the disciples; it also brought peace to every boat nearby.

Dear brothers and sisters, sometimes God allows us to walk through difficulties, storms, trials, and unexpected seasons because He intends to use our deliverance to bring hope to others.

Your breakthrough can become someone else's blessing.

Your prayer can open doors for another person.

Your perseverance can strengthen someone who is silently struggling.

(Life experiences of Pastor S. Sam Selva Raj)

"Whoever reads, let him understand" (Matthew 24:15)

Whatever your hand finds to do, do it with your might... - Ecclesiastes 9:10.

He who observes the wind will not sow, and he who regards the clouds will not reap. - Ecclesiastes 11:4.

It had long been my desire to teach the profound truths of the Bible to people from all walks of life through Bible Correspondence Courses and Bible Colleges. This burden was deeply rooted in my heart and continued to grow stronger over the years. However, I found myself helpless, as I had neither a source of income nor anyone to guide and support me in this vision. During that period, my family and I lived in poverty, enduring great hardship in a small house with very few facilities.



In 1980, I received a Gospel packet from an organization called India Bible Literature (IBL). Upon opening it, I found several Gospel tracts and a correspondence course booklet. As I read through them, I became deeply interested in using similar materials to reach people across India in various languages. Without delay, I rode my old bicycle to the India Bible Literature office at Thousand Lights, Chennai.



There, I met a young man named Mr. Velu, also known as Mr. Velayutham, who now serves as the Executive Director. Watching him carefully pack and

dispatch correspondence course books inspired me to do a similar work for the glory of God.

I approached him respectfully and asked whether he could provide me with some course books. He informed me that each book cost 50 paise (half a rupee). I explained that I came from a poor family and was employed in a Government Department with a

modest monthly salary. Moved by my situation, he generously gave me ten books free of charge.

Yet, I was not satisfied. I found myself gazing through the window at the many books stacked inside the dispatch hall. It seemed as though they were calling out to me, urging me to take them and place them into the hands of those who needed the knowledge of Christ. I could not bring myself to leave.

After some time, another gentleman approached me and asked, "Who are you, and why have you been standing here and looking into our office for so long?" I explained that I was a man of limited means with a great desire to serve the Living God, Jesus Christ, and that I wanted to obtain more correspondence course books. He told me that I could purchase them if I brought the necessary money.

At that moment, I made a difficult decision—I chose to sell my old bicycle, which was my only possession and means of transportation.

I immediately went to a nearby bicycle repair shop, sold my bicycle for one hundred rupees, and purchased two hundred correspondence course books. Having given up my only means of travel, I carried the books on



my shoulders and head as I walked nearly five kilometres from Thousand Lights to my home.

Unaccustomed to carrying such a heavy load, I
s o o n

exhausted. On two occasions, the books slipped from my shoulders and fell onto the road. I felt helpless and humiliated as some people mocked me during my struggle. Nevertheless, by the grace of God, I reached home safely and began distributing the books with all my strength.

With the help of the late Bro. M. Paulraj, God enabled me to launch the "New Life - For You!" Correspondence Course. Later, we established the **Echo of His Call Nehemiah Evening Bible Colleges**.

Yes, my dear friend, there was a time when I had to part with my old bicycle for the sake of the Kingdom of God. My family and friends considered it an act of foolishness and ignorance, and I



bore much shame because of that decision. Yet today, God has blessed me with vehicles and faithful co-workers to assist in His ministry.

There was also a time when I personally carried Gospel literature on my shoulders and head. It was a painful and humiliating experience during my youth. But today, God has provided cars and minibuses to carry me and transport Gospel materials and ministry workers.

Dear friend, God has a unique plan for your life and your future as well. You still have time. Whatever you surrender to the Lord for His Kingdom will never be in vain. Take Jesus Christ as your example and invest something precious in His ministry with a Kingdom-focused vision. The blessings of God upon your life will know no end.

Remember:

***There is only one life; It will soon be past;
Only what's done for Christ Jesus will last!***

Sometimes God allows us to pass through storms so that our testimony becomes another person's pathway to freedom.

Remember Paul and Silas. When they were imprisoned and chained, they did not surrender to despair. Instead, they lifted their voices in worship.

The Bible says:

... At midnight Paul and Silas were praying and singing hymns to God, and the prisoners were listening to them. Acts 16:25.

Those around you who are trapped by fear, lies, and the schemes of the enemy are listening when you walk through your storms.

What are they hearing?

Are they hearing worship, faith, and victory?

Or are they hearing fear, complaints, and discouragement?

Then suddenly:

... There was a great earthquake, so that the found-

ations of the prison were shaken; and immediately all the doors were opened and everyone's chains were loosed. Acts 16:26.

My dear brothers and sisters, Notice the word:

"Everyone."

Not just Paul and Silas - everyone got their freedom.

The prisoners who were near them, known and unknown, experienced freedom because two servants of God chose worship in the middle of suffering.

That is the power of God's grace.
