# CHOICES



The Bible says, **Draw near** to God and He will draw near to you... in James 4:8. At the same time, the Bible also says, we did not chose him, Jesus Christ chose us -You didn't choose Me. but I chose you ... John 15:16. And that He was the one who first loved us -...because He first loved us. 1 John 4:19. Nowhere does God force Himself on us to choose Him or love Him. He has always been a gentle God by giving us the Free will. Opportunity is given to all; only a few take up the given chance and make use of it.

Let us mediate on some of the choices made by some prominent Biblical characters.

## WO THIEVES!

Taking the example of two thieves who were hanging on the cross on either side of Jesus Christ, one said, "... Lord, remember me when You come into Your kingdom" Luke 23:42. Jesus Christ replied "...Today, you will be with me in Paradise". Luke 23:43; whereas the other, decided to mock Jesus Christ even at the last minute of his life. When one thief repented and asked God to remember him, the other missed the opportunity and continued to accuse Jesus Christ and find fault. It is a choice that both of them had made. No one forced either of them, but it became a life-changing choice/moment, not only for the thief who wanted to be remembered, but for all of us. That is why we are talking about it in 2023.

# **CENTURION!**

They were many centurions on duty on the day of Christ's



crucifixion, witnessing the gruesome death of the Lamb of God. They were able to see that He was different, but no one was willing to confess or accept Him for who He was, except one man. There was one centurion at the foot of Jesus Christ, while He was nailed on the cross on Calvary. He said "...Truly this was the son of God" of courage and boldness to make that statement. Even today we have our brothers and sisters who are persecuted just for their faithhumiliated, imprisoned, stripped naked, put to shame by their own people, burnt, having their elderly parents tortured etc. But, enduring all this they have withstood the test of faith. Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall trouble or hardship or persecution or famine or nakedness or danger or sword? Romans 8:35 (NIV). No one forced Paul to say what he said, but it was a choice he made.

## PILATE!

Pilate was another man who had great power to make a life changing decision for Jesus Christ, but in order to favour the people, gain good reputation and to be in

the good books of the Jews, he failed to do what he had to. The Bible says, Do not withhold good from those to whom it is due, when it is in our power to do it (Proverb 3:27) and Therefore whenever we have the opportunity we should do good to everyone (Galatians 6:10). Again it is a choice given to us and the Bible instructs to make a conscious decision to do good. A deliberate choice to make.

If God has kept you in a position or in a place where you can help the broken, the needy, the helpless, the powerless, the homeless, even the physically and mentally challenged, make a choice to help them. We need champions to fight for the right cause. Mother Teresa was such a wonderful Mathew 27:54. He confessed woman who sold out her entire life openly who Christ was. It takes a lot to help and support the weak and sick. Amy Carmichael was a champion who fought for the rights of young girls. They did what they could do to help the weaker section of the society. On the other hand it is sad to see, people being so selfcentred that they have no time for their fellow brothers and sisters. What is even more disappointing is that we see that in Churches too. May God give us the grace to change this and let us be the change.

> Pilate knew Jesus Christ was blameless, and he had the choice to release him. I think he really wanted to release Jesus Christ. However, he did not want to do it publicly. Pilate, very tactfully planned for the people to make the choice, to release either Barabbas or Jesus Christ, with the anticipation that the people would ask to release Jesus Christ. But, alas, they asked for Barabbas! Again, it was an opportunity



missed by Pilate but well used by the Jews for a wrong cause. Missed opportunities!!

How many of us have missed opportunities because we fail to make a choice when he had to! But graciously, we have a God of second chances. Even when we miss it, God always comes with another divine plan. Such is the Love of God. May be you are sitting and thinking I could have done this, I could have done that, but I am aged, I am weak, I have wasted my life!

Dear brothers and sisters, if you are thinking that you have wasted your time and it is too late to make good the lost time, it is never too late in the Kingdom of God. God's timing is perfect. God chose Moses as a leader to deliver the Israelites from captivity when he was 80 years old and not when he was 40. Caleb had the strength to fight and conquer the land in his 80s. Give your wasted years to Jesus Christ and He will make something beautiful. I am reminded of an old song.

"Give them all to Jesus. Shattered dreams, wounded hearts broken toys. Give them all to Jesus. For He will turn your sorrows into joy". Let us learn to give them all to Jesus.

# PETER!

Peter was one of the earliest disciples of Jesus Christ. Among the three who formed the inner circle of disciples of Jesus Christ, Peter was one of them. Peter was with Jesus Christ in the most significant event of His life, he even witnessed who Christ was on the Mount of Transfiguration.

I love the character of Peter! A man who had a great deal of passion and zeal. He wanted to build a tent for Jesus Christ, Moses and Elijah on the mount of Transfiguration. When Jesus Christ spoke about His gruesome death, Peter was the first to speak emotionally and said "Lord I am ready to go with You to prison and to death" (Luke 22:33). He was over protective and an angry man too. When soldiers came to arrest Jesus Christ, he cut the

soldier's ears in anger. In every way, Peter was a very emotional man that we can all relate to. He was always proactive.

Peter was a people-centred person. He must have had a close relationship with his brother Andrew and that is why when Andrew called him to meet Jesus Christ, he obliged. I am sure they must have had their share of sibling rivalry too. We also read about Peter's mother-in-law that shows he is a very close family man. Peter was also a purpose-driven man. He knew who Jesus Christ exactly was, identifying that Jesus Christ was the expected Messiah. We see these characteristics later on in his ministry too.

How did this dedicated, loving, passionate, people-loving person, who held Jesus Christ in such high regard suddenly deny Jesus Christ? Not only once but three times, that too in spite of

having been warned by the Lord. He not only betrayed he started to curse as well. When we read this, we might begin to judge Peter and condemn him for being such a horrible man. But let us think how many times as dedicated, committed followers of Christ we have betrayed Jesus Christ through our action, words and thoughts. I have heard people saying, "I slipped, it was in the spur of the moment". How many really think what Peter did was a 'spur of the moment' act? Not to be mistaken as a critic of this great apostle of God, I would like all of us to learn from his life.

Do you think it is something that happened just at that time, or was it a process?

I believe, to betray Jesus Christ is not an easy thing for a man who was so committed, loving, passionate, and purpose-driven. When do you think it all started? It is when Peter started to follow Jesus Christ at a 'distance' according to Matthew 26:58

The Bible beautifully says, Peter followed Jesus Christ at a distance. Many of us love Jesus Christ, enjoy His blessings. It is great that we know Him as our provider and protector but we are hesitant to follow Him closely and are comfortable to follow Him 'at a distance'. When we follow Him at a distance, some of us feel, it is safe, as He will not demand more from us. People will not know us as a keen follower of Christ and that we can taste the best of both, God and the world. A very interesting compromise.

Dear Friends, the Bible teaches us that we cannot be friends of the world and God at the same time in James 4:4 (NLT) - You friendship with the world makes you an enemy of God? There is no mid-way. It is either the side of the world or the side of God. If we are not on the side of God, it means we have already become the enemy of God by default. Therefore, no matter how spiritual and pious a person can be, if one decides to follow Jesus Christ at a distance, it is a dangerous place to be.

How is your walk with Christ today? Are you walking with Jesus Christ at a distance or are you walking closely with Jesus Christ? It is a choice that all of us have to make. As mentioned earlier, Jesus Christ loves us so much that He will never force us to do anything but has given us a Free Will. However, He has also expressed His desire If you remain in me and my words remain in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be done for you (John 15:7). This teaches us the importance of having a closer walk with God.

Dear Friends, the world that adulterers! Don't you realise that we live in is so complicated and demanding. To juggle our work, our family and personal life is a challenge by itself. Sometimes the things that we face in our lives such as disappointments, hurt, betrayal, separation, death, back stabbing, can cause mental exhaustion. I don't know how many of you are in similar situation; may be you are saying "I am living a life as a consequence of decision made by someone else, I don't deserve this". This might have caused you to stop following Jesus Christ like Judas or following Jesus Christ at a distance like Peter. But the point is, both are dangerous.

> Peter's denial of Jesus Christ did not happen all of a sudden, it was a slow process. The moment Jesus Christ was arrested, fear gripped everyone, as to what is going to happen to their future. At the same time, Peter wanted to know what is happening to his Master so he decided to follow him at a distance.

# PIT TO PALACE

(Life experiences of Pastor S. Sam Selva Raj)

"Whoever reads, let him understand" (Matthew 24:15)



### **HIS GUIDANCE AND PROVIDENCE IN MY LIFE!**

### He will fulfill the desire of them that fear Him - Psalm 145:19

The Lord Jesus Christ was so gracious towards me by enabling me to start Church Ministry in the place called Chepauk, Chennai (Madras) in the year 1982. From its inception, the Church had been experiencing the problem of shifting from one place to another, due to financial inadequacy as well as the opposition and jealousy from anti-Christian friends of the area.

Finally, we were conducting our Sunday Worship Services in a small room inside a house where there was no ventilation. This house was owned by a dear brother, Mr. George.

During the course of the Worship Service on a particular Sunday, the Lord un-expectedly and suddenly prompted me in the Spirit to believe Him for a spacious building of our own to conduct our Church Services in the same area. The Lord also prompted me to share this with the congregation seeking their prayer support. I obeyed the Lord and shared this in the Church Service.

- The people who were in the Church listened to me and started mocking at me through their sarcastic look.
- They questioned "Is it really possible to buy a property based on our poor financial status?".
- Some people tried to give me spiritual pressure asking, "Even if we have the money, where could we find a property available for sale in this thickly populated area?
- Few friends came forward with a critical and doubtful question, "Is it fair for a decent man of God to tell to the people such an impracticable message, even in the name of God?"

By these means, I was severely pushed into various confusing situations. I was unable to find out a single person who was able to stand with me accepting my challenge of faith. The common public

finally ended up with the conclusion that the Christian preachers have no other job other than keep on uttering such unacceptable and impracticable stories. They did not recognize vision too.

But I was not disheartened. On the contrary, the Lord comforted me and granted me His grace to lean strongly on Him, the One Who is the author and finisher of our faith (Hebrews 12:1). The Lord entered into my heart with His Word "Fear not, you worm Jacob, you men of Israel! I will help you," says the Lord and your Redeemer, the Holy One of Israel. "Behold, I will make you into a new threshing sledge with sharp teeth; you shall thresh the mountains, and beat them small, and shall make the hills like chaff" Isaiah 41: 14,15.

The days went by. God blessed me in front of all the people around me and graciously blessed us with a wonderful place for His ministry in the same place where God gave me the vision.

But after getting hold of the place, I did not have money to buy the property, as expected by the people of my area. I tried to obtain help from my known sources, but no one came forward to help me as I was financially very poor. In this situation, the Government came forward to grant me a personal building advance buying the property, as I was working for the Government during that time. In order to achieve this, God used a non-Christian friend Mr. Kannan and another Christian friend Mr. M.P. Jeyakumar. Jesus Christ is faithful. Jesus Christ is good all the time. All the time Jesus Christ is good. What a wonderful God we have! Oh! taste and see that the Lord is good... Psalm 34:8.

Even today, when I write this message also, I can tell you that my life is rugged and full of challenges. I am crushed by so many difficulties and untold miseries in my daily life for carrying out the

I have the experience of sleepless nights, and nights in which I do not wish to sleep. I have learned that the Lord Jesus Christ is the only One who is faithful and worthy to be counted upon, as a True Friend in this world which is covered with darkness, evil pressures and hopelessness. Because, I am able to experience His guidance and providence in my life. The following lines of a famous hymn is my experience:

Lead, kindly Light, amidst the encircling gloom, lead Thou me on!

The night is dark, and I am far from home; lead Thou me on!

Keep Thou my feet; I do not ask to see The distant scene; one step enough for me.

I know that my daily life is full of trials and difficulties. But I have the assurance that when I finish my work in this world, I will enter and inherit my Heavenly Home and meet my Master Jesus Christ face to face and hug His golden face and share my experiences in this world. I am eagerly waiting for that wonderful day. That day will be the great day! That day will be the most blessed day!!

Dear friend, do you have such a hope and longing?
