even before the creation of the world (Eph. 2:10).

Reflecting on how intricately God has designed each one of us. I realize that our existence is not accidental but part of a divine plan. Even if one might believe they were unwanted or unexpected by their earthly parents. God has carefully crafted each individual, as stated in Psalms 139:13, "You made all the delicate, inner parts of my body and knit me together in my mother's womb." Therefore, it is our responsibility to seek out and fulfill the purpose for which we were created, with the guidance of the author and finisher of our faith.

God graces us with divine calling and gifts not based on our merit, but on His character. Yet, it is

casy to stray from this path, often with his head and shoulders imperceptibly, until we find ourselves far from our intended course. Thankfully, the Holy Spirit is ever present to guide us back to the path of our loving Savior.

Let us explore some of the common steps that can divert us from God's divine purpose using the life of Saul, the first king of Israel as an example.

Saul: Not only the beginning is important, but also the end!

When the people of Israel requested a king, rejecting the king of kings as their ruler, God granted their wish. Saul, the son of Kish, a wealthy and prominent man from the tribe of Benjamin, was anointed as the first king. Saul possessed all the worldly qualities befitting a king. The Scripture describes him as taller than anyone in the land,

standing above the rest (1 Sam 9:2). So, what led this chosen. anointed, and talented man to meet a tragic end?



Saul lacked confidence when God called him to kingship. He even expressed, "I am only from the tribe of Benjamin, the smallest tribe in Israel, and my family is the least significant of all the families in that tribe!" (1 Sam 9:21). Despite being anointed, he remained shy and tried to hide (1 Sam 10:22). We must remember that God will not call us where His grace cannot sustain us. His grace was enough for Saul to become the first king of Israel. Despite his

humble beginnings, God blessed the dangers of pride. him. However, as he tasted success and achieved victory after victory, the ensuing fame and adulation, like for many of us, blinded him.

In 1 Sam 15, we encounter a familiar passage where God commanded Saul to utterly destroy the Amalekites, sparing no one. including women and children. When viewed in the present day, it may seem brutal and paint God as cruel and vengeful. However, considering the history of the Israelites, the Amalekites had tormented, attacked, and sought to annihilate the weary and vulnerable Israelites.

BEWARE!

Zechariah 2:8 - "He who touches surface unexpectedly. you touches the apple of His eye".

God was displeased with how the Amalekites mistreated His people, whom He considers His cherished possession, and He sought to avenge them. It is important to remember that we have a God who fights our battles on our behalf. However, in the story of Saul, we see a different response. When corrected by Samuel for his actions. Saul's immediate reaction should have been one of confession and repentance. Instead, he asked Samuel to honor him before the elders and the people of Israel, requesting him to come back so that he could worship "the LORD your God" (1 Samuel 15:30). This shift in Saul's attitude from humility to pride is evident as he seeks recognition and even builds a monument to honor himself (1 Samuel 15:12).

Success and victory can often lead to changes in our mindset and attitude. Saul's transformation from a humble man to one seeking honor and recognition illustrates

The moment pride takes hold. God may withdraw His presence from our lives and even stand against us (Isaiah 63:10). James 4:6 warns that God opposes the proud but shows favor to the humble. It is a sobering reminder to reflect on our own words and actions. How often do we assert our ownership and knowledge with phrases like "my house," "my life," or "I know best"? Even if we outwardly profess humility, our true nature may reveal itself when our pride is challenged. The tendency to assert our importance with phrases like "Do you know who I am?" or "How The Bible states in dare you speak to methis way?" can

> This cautionary tale serves as a reminder to guard against the pitfalls of pride, especially in moments when our sense of self is threatened. Whether spoken by

individuals or even echoed in the minds of those who profess faith, the refrain of "Do you know who I am?" should serve as a warning against the insidious nature of pride.



A person with selfdeception is someone who:

- 1) Believes to be what indeed they are not.
- Thinks they have more than they have.
- Desires to appear as something they are not, rather than desiring to be authentic.

Now, let's explore what the Bible says:

- "Don't think too highly of yourself." (Romans 11:20)
- "If anyone thinks he is

something when he is not, he judgment. deceives himself." (Romans 12:3)

* "Pride leads to self-deception." (Obadiah 1:3)

This pattern is evident in the life of Saul; his pride blinded and deceived him, leading to selfdeception.

How do we fall and what happens When we fall into the trap of self-deception:-

(A) UNWILLING TO FULLY OREY GOD!

For instance, God commanded Saul to wipe out the Amalekites, saying, "Now go and completely destroy." (1 Samuel 15:2). However, Saul deceived himself by choosing to keep "all that was good" (1 Samuel 15:9). He took it upon himself to judge what was worth keeping, thereby deceiving himself into thinking his actions were justified. Saul even claimed, "I have carried out the LORD's command" (1 Samuel 15:13), despite deviating from God's instructions.

Many times, like Saul, we deceive ourselves into believing that our actions align with God's will when, in reality, they fall short. Only deeds done in accordance with God's will are pleasing to Him,

(B) UNWILLING TO ACCEPT HIS FAULTS



Saul tries to justify disobedience in a spiritual way

Pride and self-deception blinded his eyes, numbed his heart, and deafened his ears, preventing him from hearing the voice of God. He blamed the people, saying, "The people (not me) spared the best of the sheep and oxen to sacrifice to

the Lord." Saul is trying to spiritualize his disobedience. This is why God emphasizes that obedience is better than sacrifice. Self-deception leads us to blame others for our actions instead of taking responsibility.

(C) UNWILLING TO HUMBLE HIMSELF!

Saul was at the height of his pride.

- He built a monument for himself:
- He insisted that Samuel honor him.
- He sought the honor of the people over God's recognition.
- Instead of humbling himself before God and seeking forgiveness, he desired to be exalted among his people.

As mentioned earlier, all our actions have consequences.

GOD HONOURS OUR TINY EFFORTS!

Oh, give thanks to the LORD -Who remembered us in our lowly state, for His mercy endures forever. - Psalm 186:1.23

From the beginning of my ministerial life, God gave me the mind to go to any extent and to take up any challenge to glorify God for the extension of His kingdom, without expecting any immediate reward. From the year 1976 to 1986, I was in the habit of applying leave from my government office and arrange gospel tours and preaching the gospel by means of mini crusades in different parts of India by spending my own money.

The Lord helped me to take my spiritual friends with me to various parts at least for one or two months together and go to the unreached villages and touch the lives of thousands of people through the gospel of Jesus Christ. Several times, I had to depend upon God for all my financial needs, as I had to buy train tickets, bus tickets, book hotel accommodation for me and my colleagues. God miraculously helped me.

Through this ministry, God helped me to visit various remote areas in Chengalpet District, Villupuram District, Madurai District, Trichy District and Kanyakumari District, Kodaikaanal, Ootacamund, Trivandrum, Peelamedu, Idukki, Vandiperiyar, Vijayawada, Bangalore, Mysore etc. During my trips, I experienced different kinds of physical sufferings in transporting our musical instruments and gospel tracts from one place to another by means of buses and trains. Due to my low financial status, I could not even think of having a vehicle for the ministry. But God was watching my attitude and listening to my testimonies. God is not unrighteous to forget your work and labour of love, which ye have shewed toward His name, in that ye have ministered to the saints, and do minister (Hebrews 6:10).

Later on I found that God blessed all my coworkers and elevated them to higher levels and continuous to use them mightily in His vineyard even today. He also blessed me with all facilities like latest equipment, cars, vans and zealous workers and is enabling me more and more to preach the gospel to the unsaved people of India. Also God honoured me, took me to various countries of the world and blessed me with good friends.

The same God is still alive. He is searching for willing persons who can come forward to serve Him without expecting any immediate rewards, high positions and corrupted motives. Cast your bread upon the waters; for you will find it after many days Ecclesiastres 11:1. He is not a debtor to anybody.

Personally I have learned that if we have a desire to do something for God's Kingdom, we should do it immediately, without observing the wind and regarding the clouds as He who observes the wind will not sow and he who regards the clouds will not reap. Ecclesiastes 11:4. The world and the worldly people will stand with you.

Now-a-days, our people do not want to invest their health, money and talents in advancing the kingdom of God; instead expect immediate elevation and on the spot rewards. Dear friend, I am really blessed because of the gospel of Jesus Christ. He can really bless you also. Can you come forward to do something for Jesus Christ now? Can you take up your cross and follow Him? God is searching for willing persons who are really interested to send forth His glorious gospel – in any – in every way – at all cost. 1 Corinthians 9:22.

Partial obedience is tantamount to complete disobedience.

- Saul grieved God through his actions.
- This led to God's immediate rejection of him.
- Both God and Samuel regretted making him a king.

He strayed from God's will, losing his way. Let us pray that none of us will lead a life like Saul's, deviating from our life's purpose.



Saul's pride led him to self-deception, causing him to assume a false identity and foster a rebellious and stubborn nature. Rebellion is synonymous with disobedience and obstinacy, and it carries consequences. Proverbs 29:1 warns that a person who remains stubborn after many rebukes will face sudden and irremediable destruction. His destruction will come suddenly upon him.

Saul, unaware that his rebellious nature would impact not only himself but also future generations, displayed a rebellious attitude by not waiting for Samuel and offering sacrifices, a duty reserved for the priest. Upon being rebuked, he remained stubborn, ultimately leading to the loss of his throne. Every act of disobedience and rebellion carries its consequences.

Rebellion entails refusing to submit to someone's authority, emphasizing the importance of being submissive to authority figures. Within our families, we must show submission to our

parents, spouses, elders, managers, church leaders, pastors, supervisors, and most importantly, to God.

Rebellion is a matter of the heart, not just behavior; it signifies a need for a change within ourselves.

The Bible teaches us valuable lessons about rebelliousness:

- Rebellion is likened to witchcraft, something detested by God (1 Samuel 15:23).
- God not only withdraws but also fights against those with disobedient and rebellious natures (Isaish 63:10).
- God's hand will work against us (1 Samuel 12:14,15).
- Failure to repent may lead God to hand us over to destruction (1 Corinthians 5:5)

Dear friends, if our hearts are hardened, resistant to change, devoid of warmth, we must seek God's help to transform them. Scripture reminds us that "he who stands firm to the end will be saved" (Matthew 24:13). While God's call and gifts are irrevocable, we can hinder the Holy Spirit within us through actions like pride, self-deception, rebelliousness, and straying from God's purpose, potentially leading

to failure. Let us guard against pride's destructive influence and seek to recognize and correct our mistakes that may divert us from our purpose in life. It is crucial that we take time to reflect on our lives to ensure we stay aligned with God's will.
